The notice shall contain the date of the election, name the offices for which candidates may file, and state the qualifications required by the principal act for each office. The notice shall state the location where official declarations of candidacy for eligible candidates desiring to file for any of the elective offices may be obtained, the office in which completed declarations of candidacy are required to be filed, and the date and time after which no declarations of candidacy may be accepted for filing. A copy of the notice shall be delivered to the district secretary and shall be posted in the district office.</p>

<p>E-113 – 88 May 4 – May 29</p>	<p>Candidates / District / Registrar of Voters</p>	<p>NOMINATION PERIOD §§,10510 ,10602, 13107, 13307, 13309,13311 Between these dates candidates may obtain and file declarations of candidacy. Forms are available at the Registrar of Voters office. All forms must be filed with the Registrar of Voters by the filing deadline. It is the responsibility of each candidate to deliver their nomination documents to the Registrar of Voters by 5 p.m. on the deadline date. The ballot designation worksheet must be filed. Candidates who want to file a candidate statement must file it at the same time the Declaration of Candidacy is filed. Candidate Statements are confidential until the deadline for filing has passed. No person shall file nomination documents for more than one district office at the same time.</p>

<p>E-90 – E-0 May 27 – August 25</p>	<p>Candidates / Registrar of Voters</p>	<p>24 HOUR INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURE REPORT <u>Independent expenditures that total in the sum of \$1,000 or more to support or oppose a single candidate for elective local office or a single local ballot measure must be reported as 24-hour independent expenditures during the 90 days immediately preceding the election in which the candidate or measure will be voted on.</u> <u>File Form 496 within 24 hours of making the independent expenditure(s).</u></p>
<p>E-88 May 29</p>	<p>Candidates / Registrar of Voters</p>	<p>LAST DAY TO FILE DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY AND / OR WITHDRAW § 13307 Last day for candidates to file their Declarations of Candidacy and Candidate Statements with the Registrar of Voters. Candidate Statements are optional. Candidate must withdraw before 5 p.m., unless there is an extension of the nomination period. Candidate statements must not exceed 200 words, and will be included in the official County Sample Ballot / County Voter information Guide. The statement shall be paid for at the time of filing.</p>

<p>E88 – E68 May 29 - June 18</p>	<p>Registrar of Voters</p>	<p>DEATH OF A CANDIDATE-GENERAL PROVISIONS §§ 10529,15402 If during this period the election official determines a candidate who qualified for the ballot has died, the deceased candidate's name shall not be printed on the ballot. If a candidate dies after the 68th day before the election, his or her name remains on the ballot. If the deceased candidate wins, the vacancy in the office shall be treated as if that candidate had died after taking office.</p>
<p>E-87 May 30*</p>	<p>Candidates / Registrar of Voters</p>	<p>LAST DAY TO WITHDRAW CANDIDATE STATEMENT § 13307 Last day to withdraw candidate statements, unless there is an extension of the nomination period. Withdrawal of candidate statements must be in writing.</p>
<p>E-83 June 3</p>	<p>Candidates / District / Registrar of Voters</p>	<p>EXTENSION OF NOMINATION PERIOD § 10516 If a declaration of candidacy for an incumbent member of a special district is not filed by 5 p.m. on the 88th day before the election, any person other than the incumbent shall have until 5 p.m. on the 83rd day before the election to file a declaration of candidacy for the elective office. The nomination extension is not applicable where there is no incumbent eligible to be elected. If the extension is applicable, a candidate may withdraw his or her declaration of candidacy until 5 p.m. on the 83rd day before the election.</p>

E-6 to E-0 August 19 - August 25	Registrar of Voters	REQUEST FOR VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS – LATE CONDITIONS § 3021 On or between these dates, vote-by-mail ballots are available at the Registrar of Voters office for voters who have conditions preventing them from receiving a vote-by-mail ballot via USPS. A written application signed by the voter under penalty of perjury is required unless the Vote-by-mail ballot is voted in the office of the elections official at the time of the request. The voter may designate any authorized representative to return the voted vote-by-mail ballot.
E-0 August 25	Registrar of Voters	ELECTION DAY! § 4103 Mail ballots must be postmarked and signed on or before Election Day.

<p>E+2 to E+28 August 27 - September 24</p>	<p>Registrar of Voters</p>	<p>OFFICIAL CANVASS PERIOD § 15301, 15372 Beginning no later than the Thursday following the election, the Registrar of Voters office must begin the official canvass of the precinct returns. The canvass must be completed no later than September 24th, 2015.</p>
<p>December 4</p>	<p>Registrar of Voters</p>	<p>TERM BEGINS §10505 Newly elected directors take office on this day. (1st Friday in December)</p>
